Officials and Water Safety

Please remember clubs MUST enter Officials and Water Safety as per the ratio and rosters outlined in the 2015/2016 Team Manager's & Official's Handbook.

At this carnival there will be 4 x 2 hour water safety shifts across all water areas. The water safety shifts will be at 8.30-10.30am, 10.30am-12.30pm, 12.30pm-2.30pm, 2.30-finish.

Officials should have a minimum qualification of junior official. Clubs are welcome to put forward officials that have not yet attended a Junior Officials or Level 1 course, however these individuals will need to be under supervision of an accredited official, and must attend the next available officials course.
