



Taking the plunge into the Victorian Water Safety Certificate (VWSC) A step-by-step guide for schools

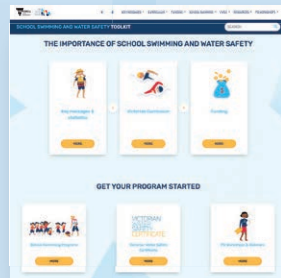
Did you know?

The Victorian Curriculum anticipates that students will demonstrate the competencies of the Victorian Water Safety Certificate by the time they leave Year 6. **Follow the steps** below to ensure your students work towards achieving their VWSC.

STEP 1

Get prepared

1] Download the free information, templates and checklists from the School Swimming and Water Safety Toolkit to start planning your school swimming and water safety program. www.lsv.com.au/toolkit



STEP 2

Find a friendly aquatic provider

1] Locate an aquatic facility which offers a school swimming program aligned to the Victorian Curriculum.
 2] When booking, advise that you would like your students assessed to the VWSC and confirm the assessment data required.
 3] Confirm if the facility will order the FREE certificates or if the school will order them from the easy online platform. www.lsv.com.au/vwsc

STEP 3

Team up

1] To make ordering the certificates easy, provide your student lists to the aquatic facility in the exact Excel spreadsheet format as required by the VWSC online ordering system.
 2] By both school and aquatic facility using the **exact** same Excel spreadsheet format, data will automatically sync with the VWSC online ordering platform.

STEP 4

Value add

1] Complement the practical in-pool swimming component by delivering 'dry swimming' and/or water safety lessons in class.

STEP 5

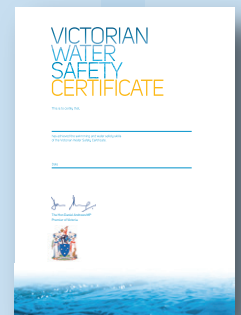
Keep a record

1] Request the facility record the students' assessment and VWSC attainment data and return this to the school at the conclusion of the swimming program.
 2] Communicate each student's assessment data to parents, advising them on what the data shows about their child's skills, knowledge and abilities, along with suggested next steps.
 3] Provide parents with a copy of the resource: **Your child has completed school swimming – what next? and Pathways beyond school swimming poster** found in the toolkit www.lsv.com.au/toolkit

STEP 6

Celebrate!

1] Upload the completed spreadsheet to the VWSC online ordering system to access your students' certificates.
 2] Celebrate your students' VWSC achievements with an official Award Ceremony, newsletter article or open water fun day!
