Guidelines for Selection

The award is open to all Life Saving Victoria parents with registered junior members between the ages of 6 and 14 during the 2007/2008 season.

A state selection panel has been formed to judge the award from the submissions made from each Club nominee.

The evaluation criteria for the final selection will be based on **Extraordinary Volunteer Service to Lifesaving Youth**.

Applications are based on the nominee's commitment over the past twelve months and may include information relating to any of the following criteria:

- Respect gained by other parents and Junior members;
- Provide a role model for other parents;
- Dedication shown in getting their own family plus others to participate in Life Saving Victoria programs and events;
- New initiatives created to improve the youth lifesaving experience;
- Continuous improvement strategies implemented;
- Areas of general assistance around the club;
- Age group leader/manager roles held;
- Coaching or official accreditations gained;
- Lifesaving awards gained during the period with club, (i.e. Bronze, IRB Driver, etc.);
- Water safety duties completed for club programs or carnivals;
- Team Manager details - organising other parents and junior members for and at carnivals;
