A2 Entries

All competitors must be current financial and proficient members of Life Saving Victoria to enter events.

Clubs this season will have the option to complete entries via the online entry system or via hard copy.

Please note – Boat Competitors will need to indicate their Boat Crew & Category.

On-line Entries

A number of changes have been made to the Interfuse system previously used for the Victorian Championships.

Team managers will be required to enter members electronically through the www.lifesavingvictoria.com.au website under the Aquatic Sports menu item, please follow the links under administration. Alternatively the site can be accessed via www.registration.lifesavingvictoria.com.au.

Team Managers **only** must obtain a username and password from the Manager Aquatic Sports on 9676 6937 or email chris.munro@lifesavingvictoria.com.au. Interstate competitors must obtain an entry form from the Manager of Aquatic Sport.

Please read the instructions posted on the website on how to use the system.

Boat competitors can be entered via the following codes:

A2 Registration

Registration will take place from **8:00 am**.

Prior to competing, each competitor will be required to nominate the age group under which he/she will be competing. He/she will then be confined to that age group for the duration of the carnival. In individual events where two or less starters are prepared to contest an event, those competitors may contest a lower age group in that event, without prejudice to their age category in other events. If there is no event listed at all for that particular age group, this also enables competitor/s to contest a lower age group in that event, without prejudice to their age category in other events

Competitors will not be able to compete if they have not registered.

A3 Entry Fees

Competitor entry in the 2008 Life Saving Victoria Masters championships is **\$20.00** per competitor, clubs will be invoiced following the competition.

Late entries will be taken on the day charged at **twice** the competitor entry fee ie. **\$40.00**

A4 Medals

Medals for the championships will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd placegetters.

Please note

Events that have only 1 competitor will not be eligible to receive a medal.

Events will be added to the program if there are more than 4 people to compete.

A5 Officials Requirements

The following ratio of Officials per Competitor is to be used:

Clubs must provide 1 Official per 10 competitors eg 0-9 competitors = 0 Official, 10-19 competitors = 1 official, 20-29 competitors = 2 Officials etc.

If Clubs fail to supply Officials in the above ratio the Clubs not complying will have their competitors banned from the day's competition.

Please Note - Team managers will be required to enter officials either via the online carnival entries system or hardcopy forms as per the ratio. Team managers will need to enter officials via the "000" code.
