Following the success of last year's IRB Maintenance Workshop, the State Powercraft Panel advise that another weekend camp in planned for 11, 12 and 13 July, 2008.

### WORKSHOP INFORMATION

This workshop is aimed at all lifesaving clubs, IRB Captains or any club personnel interested in the repair and maintenance of their club's IRBs.

The workshop will cover the following areas:

#### **A. Boat Maintenance**

- Inflation
- Patching
- Replace lifting handle
- Replace hinges

#### **B. Motor Maintenance**

- Remove "In Gear Start Mechanism" (SLSA requirement)
- Remove "Tilt Lock Mechanism" (SLSA requirement)
- Fit Prop guard (SLSA requirement)
- Remove Ready Pull, remove & replace Starter Pawl
- Correct fitment of spark plugs / boots
- Remove & Replace propeller
- Remove / replace spinner/clamp screw cups
- Fit thermostat to Tohatsu
- Adjust Tilt friction

- Rollover Procedure
- Surf Kit

### **C. Splicing / Ancillary Equipment**

The camp will commence on Friday evening for registration and introductions. Training sessions will be run on both Saturday and Sunday, concluding at approximately 2.00 pm (see attached program for more information).

It is a live weekend utilising Lorne SLSC accommodation and all meals will be provided at the club.
