Subject: Boating Safety and Facilities Program Grants

Action: Applications to LSV close 5:00 pm Tuesday 8 July, 2008

Clubs are advised that applications are open for the Boating Safety and Facilities Grants Program through Marine Safety Victoria. This year, the grants are divided into five (5) areas:

- Education and Training
- Search and Rescue (SAR) Vessels and Equipment
- Navigational Aids and Signage
- Boating Facilities and Community Harbours
- Marine Communications

Club applications are processed through Life Saving Victoria.

Clubs need to have their duly completed applications form returned to LSV HQ by 5:00 pm Tuesday 8 July, 2008, marked for the attention of Greg Scott – Support Officer, Life Saving Services.

It is most essential that applications are entirely complete. Partially completed applications or those missing required documentation will not be considered by Marine Safety Victoria. Clubs are reminded that this is a boating safety grant, and as such, applications will need to demonstrate a contribution to boating safety within Victoria (as opposed to swimmer safety).

To be successful in the grants process, clubs need to show they meet the Marine Safety Victoria criteria applicable to the area of the grant applied for.
