A2 Rules & Regulations

Clubs are reminded that to take part in Pool Competitions there are a number of rules and regulations relating to equipment, training and competition rules that need to be taken into consideration. A3 Entry Procedure

Entry Procedure

Entry fee will also be as per the summer season with \$12.00 (GST inclusive) being charged per competitor.

- (a) All entries for the season will be processed through our online registration website:
www.registration.lifesavingvictoria.com.au/tide/registration
- (b) All clubs are advised to read the entry process closely to ensure there is no confusion as to the procedure that should be followed.
- (c) The internet registration system uses a club username and login as per Victorian Championships. **Please contact Life Saving Victoria on (03) 9676 6937 or email chris.munro@lifesavingvictoria.com.au if you are unsure of your club's login.**
- (d) Please click on point one "read instructions for entries" on the www.registration.lifesavingvictoria.com.au/tide/registration site for information how to enter competitors into competitions.
- (e) Click on enter competitors into Events (Click All to review all competitors) (it is recommended that clubs use the appropriate dummy competition to import competitors into future carnivals, as the system is also used for results and entry fee processing i.e names will be deleted from each carnival)
- (f) Please have the following information ready before entering competitors into events.
 - Surname and Given Name (No Nicknames)
 - Gender – (M/F)
 - Membership Category (A – Active, RA - Reserve Active, LM – Life Member, C – Cadet)
 - Date of Birth
- (g) All invoices for entries will be issued to clubs following the events.

Please Note:

Entries close at **5:00 pm on the Thursday prior** to each carnival. Late entries can be made on the day at the administration desk and will incur a late fee charge of \$15. Changes to team sheets can be made until (one) hour after the advertised carnival start time.

A4 Entry Fees

Senior Pool Carnival \$12.00 per carnival

LSV will send out an invoice to all of the participating Clubs after each Carnival. A \$2.00 pool entry fee will also be charged for spectators on entry to the pool.

A5 Competition Eligibility

All Members of LSV, Affiliated Clubs, Pool Lifeguards, Swimming Groups and their members, Members of educational institutions and approved lifesaving clubs will be permitted to enter competitors and or teams in the 2008 Pool Lifesaving Carnivals and Championships.

No award qualifications are required for normal Carnivals (but all competitors must be able to confidently swim 25m minimum), however Competitors must, at the closing date for the State Championship entries, be holders of a minimum RLSSA or SLSA Award qualification relevant to the age group/s they are competing in.

Under 14 Senior Swim & Survive
Under 16 Bronze Star or higher
Under 19 Bronze Medallion
Open Bronze Medallion
Over 30 Bronze Medallion
Over 40 Bronze Medallion

SLSA

Surf Rescue Certificate
Surf Rescue Certificate or Bronze Medallion

Competitors that subsequently are found not to hold the appropriate award/s will not be allowed to compete or will be disqualified and all medals returned on request.

Ages shall be taken from the first (1st) day of January preceding the Championships, i.e. 1 January 2008.

All non lifesaving club groups must register their cap with the event coordinator prior to competing. Registered club/group caps shall be worn in all events, but if worn in the Initiative Test, should not be used as a rescue aid.

Swimming and lifesaving techniques shall be based on those used in the ILS Manual of Swimming and Lifesaving.

A6 Officials

Each Club or School must provide Officials to assist with pool duties i.e. Timekeeping. These officials are asked to please wear a white t-shirt or polo shirt to the competitions.
