Due to no applications received for Officials positions, the Aquatic Sports Executive is now calling for nominations for Education Officer Positions to accompany the Victorian Wieland Shield team to America.

Since 1967, the Los Angeles County Lifeguards and (Surf) Life Saving Victoria have been exchanging competitive and educational tours on a bi-annual basis.

A perpetual trophy for competition between (Surf) Life Saving Victoria and American teams was awarded during the visit of the USA team to Australia in 1967. The trophy, made from Victorian red gum wood, is retained by the winning team until the next opportunity comes for competition between Victoria and the United States. The idea for the trophy came from the then American Consul-General in Victoria, Mr W. A. Wieland.

Successful nominations for these positions are expected to choose an area of specific interest to investigate. A report on this area of interest is required upon returning to Australia.

Whilst Life Saving Victoria can provide some office support, all applicants should be aware the total tour cost is to be covered by the team's fundraising and individual financial commitments.

Applications are now invited for the following positions:

- 2 x Education Officer Positions

- Education Officers will be expected to participate in fundraising activities (remaining cost to be covered by the individual)
- \$100 refundable deposit is to be paid with all nominations.

Length of tour will be approximately 14-21 days leaving Friday 18 July 2008, with the approximate cost of each individual being \$4,000.
