Subject: Silver Medallion - Basic Beach Management Facilitator Training

Action: Enrol members in Facilitator Courses

A series of State-run Facilitator - Silver Medallion - Basic Beach Management training sessions will take place over the coming months to help clubs achieve patrol requirements for the coming season.

A Facilitator – Silver Medallion – Basic Beach Management (SM – BBM) will be able to deliver the SM – BBM course and assess the participants.

To attend the Facilitator courses you must meet the following criteria:

1. Hold Bronze Medallion
2. Hold Cert II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue)
3. Experienced Patrol Captain OR Senior Lifeguard
4. Certificate IV TAA or BSZ units of competency
 - Train Small Groups
 - Plan Assessment
 - Conduct Assessment
 - Review Assessment

OR

 - Provide training through instruction and demonstration of work skills
 - Plan and organise assessment
 - Assess competence
 - Contribute to assessment validation
5. Basic Beach Management Award

Dispensation from criteria 5 available from Director – T&A, but candidate must be willing to undergo an RPL Assessment for Basic Beach Management

Facilitator – Silver Medallion - Basic Beach Management courses listed below are open to any club member who meets the pre-requisites above. Names of people who

attend these courses will be passed on to the Director of Training and Assessment for endorsement.

Facilitator Training Days are as follows:

Saturday	11 October	Frankston LSC
Sunday	12 October	Hampton LSC
Sunday	19 October	Life Saving Victoria

Costs for Facilitator training will be covered by Life Saving Victoria.
