Additional registration requirements for State Requalification.

Due to Certificate II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue) now becoming a requirement for all requalifying bronze holders, if a member has not yet obtained their Certificate II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue) the following options are available:

Q1) 'I obtained my bronze medallion pre 2006 and have not completed the upgrade paper to obtain my Cert II in Public safety.'

A1) You are required to complete an in-depth proficiency and must see your chief instructor to obtain a copy of the in-depth proficiency paper to complete prior to arriving at the state requalification. If a person turns up having not completed these requirements then they will be allowed to take part in the proficiency **but will not be deemed competent** until such time as they return the in-depth paper to their chief instructor.

**People without a cert II who enrol online for state requalification will be provided with an in-depth proficiency paper to complete and return to their chief instructor prior to state requalification.*

Q2) 'I completed my bronze medallion post 2006 and never completed my workbook required for the Cert II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue).'

A2) You are required to complete an additional test paper and must see your chief instructor to obtain a copy of the additional test paper to complete prior to arriving at the state requalification. If a person turns up having not completed these requirements then they will be allowed to take part in the proficiency **but will not be deemed competent** until such time as they return the in-depth paper to their chief instructor.

**People without a cert II who enrol online for state requalification will be provided with an in-depth proficiency paper to complete and return to their chief instructor prior to state requalification.*

Q3) 'I already have my Cert II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue). Are there any additional requirements for me?'

A3) No, you simply need to either pre-enrol online or turn up on the night and you will be able to complete your proficiency.

**Your club chief instructor can assist you in completing both the Cert II assessment outlined above.*
