Key Selection Criteria;

Ideal candidate: We seek applicants who are current lifesaving leaders, with experience leading and training large groups, with a range of ages and experience. You will possess a friendly 'can-do' attitude, with a willingness to 'roll up your sleeves' as required.

Specific requirements: Must have excellent interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to work as part of a team. Highly desirable experience in the Lifeguard service and/or specialist training skills, strong lifesaving skills and have a track record of excellence and leading by example. You must possess relevant training and/or facilitation awards. You must have a current Employment - Working with Children Check.

Personal attributes: Demonstrate the ability to lead teams and follow instruction, to overcome obstacles and 'make things happens'. Should be able to deal with high pressure and able to demonstrate a passion for the lifesaving service. Must have an understanding and willingness to adopt the values of the Australian Lifeguard Service.

Flexible: You will have a flexible, can do attitude. You will be able to co-ordinate on the run between activities. You will need to be available for some planning sessions and for the entire camp period.



To apply for the Camp Leader Positions, please write a brief application, addressing the key criteria and detailing your relevant training, assessment and lifesaving history, including a list your qualifications as confirmed on Lifesaving Online.

The application form will also provide an opportunity for those applying to make suggestions of program activities that would benefit the development of the candidates.
