Official Online Courses

Technical Official:

Technical Officials are permitted to officiate at Club & State events. Officiating roles may include, Marshall/Check-Marshall, Starter/Check-Starter, Timekeeper, Recorder and Finish Judge.

Pre-Requisites:

- 16 years+
- Working with Children Check
- SLSA Membership

The online accreditation courses for Technical Official can be accessed through the SLSA Members Area https://members.sls.com.au/SLSA Online/modules/login/index.php.

Course Fee:

The Technical Officials Course costs \$50.00 (GST inclusive) which will be paid through the SLSA payment gateway directly by the participant. Each participant will receive a white official's polo shirt and Officials Kit (includes hat, drink bottle, bum bag & resources) once all course requirements are completed.

Coaches Online Courses

Club members, age managers, parents, athletes who are interested in coaching should be encouraged to register and complete an online coaching course. Anyone who meets the prerequisites can register to do the online component of the course/s. It is important that anyone who has a coaching role at your club has a coaching accreditation.

Foundation Coach - The Foundation Coach is designed as an introduction to coaching for Juniors 6-10 years of age, e.g. Nipper Assistant Coach/Age Manager

Development Coach – The Development Coach is designed for coaches who are training squads and teaching discipline specific skills, e.g. Board or Swim Coach for Junior, Youth and Senior athletes.

Pre-Requisites for Foundation & Development Coaches:

- 16 years+
- Working With Children Check
- SLSA Membership
- Bronze Medallion (for water-based disciplines)

- Foundation Coach Course \$80.00
- Development Coach Course \$120.00
