Life Saving Victoria (LSV) is pleased to announce applications are open for the **2021 U18 Leadership Development Camp**.

**The U18 Leadership Development Camp and its program content will be pending COVID -19 Government regulations at the time of camp. We will continue to monitor the current situation and adapt if necessary to provide a COVIDSafe program.**

The camp is an opportunity for youth members to develop and enhance their leadership and lifesaving skills, to support their progress through their lifesaving journey.

Participants will have the chance to learn about their leadership style and building effective teams through fun practical activities. They will also have the opportunity to develop lifesaving, mentoring and coaching skills to utilise back at their club through on beach scenario-based training.

Participants will be mentored by current volunteer leaders and can learn, share and network with likeminded lifesavers from across the state over a three day live in camp.

The camp will be taking place on the following dates:

## Leadership Development Camp Objectives

- Understanding the characteristics of effective teams, the stages of team development and meeting team members needs
- Understanding how to lead a team to suit the different personality styles
- Developing participants communication, mentoring and coaching skills
- Providing an opportunity to build on and develop lifesaving skills through practical training scenarios
- Inspiring participants to stay involved in lifesaving through broadening their understanding of lifesaving pathways and future opportunities within LSV



## **Applicant pre – requisites**

Applicants should be:

- 16 or 17 years of age at the time of the camp
- In good standing with their club
- Eager to learn more about lifesaving and current opportunities
- Considered to be a future leader in lifesaving and seeking opportunities for personal and lifesaving development
- Wanting to learn more about how to lead teams and being a valuable team member
- Interested in building connections with members from other Victorian clubs

- Camp participant numbers will be based on restrictions and density quotients at the time of the camp

- Successful applicants will be notified on the outcome of their application via email by Friday, 29 October.

## **Camp Fees**

\$415.00 per participant (inc. GST)
