Please refer to the event map for location of set up of club tents. No pegging of tents will be permitted, club tents are to be weighted down (star pickets are **not** allowed to be used).

### Parking and Club Trailers:

Parking is available on The Esplanade and surrounding streets. Trailers can be parked in the main club car park however cars will be required to be removed. Craft drop off is available in the main car park.

Mornington LSC will be holding nippers that runs until 11:00am, so please note that parking will be very limited.

### Meetings and Event Time:

Carnival Referee and Area Referee meeting at 11.00am. Officials briefing will be conducted at 11.15am in front of the LSV administration tent. Team Managers briefing will be conducted at 11.30am in front of the LSV administration tent with marshalling of events at 11:45am, for events commencing at 12.00 midday.

**Officials Accreditation:**

Clubs are encouraged to upskill members so that **accredited** (Core/Technical/Senior) officials are nominated for all carnivals. All officials must hold a valid Working with Children Check (WWCC) and be a financial member of a club.

Core/Technical/Senior Officials – can officiate at Junior Carnival

Technical & Senior Officials – can officiate at Youth/Senior/Masters Carnivals

**Water Safety Officer Ratios**

Clubs are reminded that they must supply qualified Water Safety Officers and rescue boards/tubes for the U14 area as per the ratios below;

Number of Competitors	Water Safety/Officials Required
1 - 7	1 Water Safety Officer only (with rescue tube)
8 – 29	2 Water Safety Officers with 1 x rescue board and 1 x rescue tube
30+	2:15 ratio of Water Safety Officers. 1 x rescue board, and 1 x rescue tube

**Set Up & Pack Up Roster:**

All Clubs are required to provide 1 member per carnival they attend for set up and pack up shifts. These members are required to sign on with an LSV staff representative before commencing their shift and sign off after their shift. Set up shifts will commence at 10:30am and pack up shifts to commence as requested over the PA system.

**Food:**

The club will be running a BBQ and the kiosk will be open.



**Photography:**

- Before any photographs are taken by any person(s), photographers must obtain a media identification wristband that must be worn for the duration of the event.
- Media wristbands can be obtained by registering at the Life Saving Victoria Carnival Administration tent.
- Proof of Working with Children Check **must be** provided at registration.
