SENIOR CARNIVAL - FAIRHAVEN SLSC Sunday, 14 January 2018

LSV is pleased to advise that in conjunction with Ocean6, Fairhaven SLSC and LSV bring you a combined one-day Carnival on Sunday, 14 January 2018.

This one-day event, hosted by Fairhaven SLSC, will have LSV and Ocean6 running one combined Open arena, *noting U19 age groups will not be run in water events at this carnival.*

Entering Competitors;

1. LSV Summer Series Competitors'

Entries for the carnival close **11:00pm Tuesday, 9 January 2018**

Please remember to force a SurfGuard update before entering competitors.

For those competitors who wish to enter the LSV Carnival, as an LSV Competitor you will be eligible to enter to all events through the carnival entry system (excluding the Ironman male/female event).

As an LSV Competitor you will not be eligible for prize money in Ocean6 sponsored events or Ocean6 Championship points.

Entries must be made as per normal through the LSV online entry system located on the LSV website under sport or at: <http://sportlsv.carnival.sls.com.au/eventmgr/sport>.

2. Ocean6 Round 4 Competitors'

Ocean6 will have specific events running throughout the carnival which have prize money and championship points available.

If you wish to compete for prize money and championship points as an Ocean6 competitor you must enter these specific events through the SLSA Carnival Manager system and make payment via the below entry procedure.

All SLS competitor entries to be made via [SLSA Carnival Manager](#)

\$51.00 OPEN water competitors

\$27.00 U/17 water competitors

\$27.00 OPEN and U/17 beach competitors



Examples of Entry:

The following provide several scenarios of how competitors may register, dependent on the events entered and if they wish to be eligible for prize money and Ocean6 championship points. Please note, all Victorian club competitors, regardless of their entry method, will be eligible for pennants and LSV Championship points.

1. I wish to compete in all events, (excluding the ironman/women) as an LSV competitor, and not compete for prize money or Ocean6 Championship points:

Competitor to register only through the LSV Management System as per normal, competitor can compete in all open events scheduled in "Area 1(Open)" or "Area 2 (U17)" with the exclusion of the ironman man/women event.

Payment is LSV \$24 fee.

2. I wish to compete in all events, including ironman/women, and compete as an Ocean6 competitor to be eligible for prize money and Ocean6 Championship points -

Competitor to register:

1. Enter via Jim Wall Iron Challenge for qualifier event on Friday 12th January,
2. Enter via Ocean6 entry system and compete in all events listed in "Area 1(Open)" or "Area 2 (U17)" on the program including beach flags & sprints. Competitor will pay both Ocean6 and Jim Wall Challenge Fee.

3. I wish to compete in all events, excluding ironman/women, and compete as an Ocean6 competitor to be eligible for prize money and Ocean6 Championship points;

Competitor to register only in Ocean6 entry system and compete in all events listed in "Area 1(Open)" or "Area 2 (U17)" on the program including beach flags & sprints.

Competitor will pay one Ocean6 fee.

Important Information:

Qualification for Ironman/women Ocean6 Event

Torquay SLSC's Prestigious Surf Coast Times Jim Wall Iron Challenge on Friday 12th January is a qualification for the Ocean6 Nutri-Grain Ironman/ Women Final.

Important: for all those wishing to compete in this Ironman/women on January 14th, you must register and compete in the Jim Wall Iron Challenge.

Information Regarding Ocean6 Competitor Insurance:

Ocean6 confirms they whilst they do have Personal Accident insurance for event participants through JLT, organised by SLSA, it is important to note given there is prize money involved in their events, the Personal Accident Policy replaces the regular Workcover Policy that is in place for other lifesaving activities such as Patrol, Training, and Racing when prize money is not involved.

Coverage under Personal Accident Policies are not as broad as Workers compensation and we do encourage participants to consider Private Health Insurance Options to supplement participation in sport.

Parking and Club Trailers

Clubs are encouraged to drop club trailers (including surf boats) off on the Saturday afternoon at the property across the road from the club's beach access ramp. These Trailers will receive priority access getting on to the beach Sunday morning. The sealed and back portion of the gravel car park opposite the club will be used for boat and craft drop off and turning.

There is no guarantee of competitor or official parking opposite the club. There will be a shuttle bus run from the skate ramp carpark in Airyes Inlet (before crossing the Painkalac Creek, opposite bottom shops) which we encourage you to utilise after dropping off craft opposite club. All other event parking will be along the Great Ocean Road as first in best dressed basis.

Note: there will be no pedestrian crossing of the Great Ocean Road, the tunnel is open and fits all board and ski craft.
