## Entries

- Entries for the carnival close **11:00pm Sunday, 1 February 2021**
- Masters Championships Entries Cost: \$46.00 per competitor (this entry fee will also cover the cost of entry at Masters Championships – Beach at Altona LSC)
- Youth/Senior R&R at Masters Championships Carnival Entries: \$20.00 per competitor
- Youth/Senior Carnival Entries Cost: \$20.00 per competitor (Modified Program)
- A reminder that members must be Active 2020/21 members to be eligible for entry.
- There are **NO LATE ENTRIES and NO SCRATCHINGS**
- In line with the Victorian Government COVID-19 Restricted Activity Directions for Community Sport, the carnival will operate with a maximum of 1,000 patrons total, inclusive of athletes, required spectators and those need to run the carnival (officials, water safety, team managers). Therefore, there will be an entry cap of **500 ATHLETES TOTAL per carnival**.

### 2021 COVIDSafe Protocols

All LSV carnival attendees **MUST** adhere to all government restrictions and LSV COVIDSafe protocols. COVIDSafe Officers will be in place to ensure all attendees are following protocols.

### Club Cap Reminder

A reminder that all athletes are required to wear their club tie up caps as the most outer cap. Silicone swimming caps are not permitted as the outer cap.

### Parking and Club Trailers

- Surf Boats can be launched at the 'swimming pool entry' to the beach.
- Ski and Board trailers are permitted to be parked on the grass area of the foreshore.
- Please note that parking restrictions will be enforced around Lorne and that parking is not permitted on yellow lines.

### COVIDSafe Officer Roster

LSV will appoint a Carnival COVIDSafe Officer as part of the Carnival Safety Committee. We would also appreciate the support of clubs to nominate a parent or member who could assist the Officer in various areas for the duration of the carnival. Once entries close, we will determine the number of Officers required and roster clubs accordingly. Clubs will be notified prior to the carnival.

### Set Up & Pack Up Roster
