Junior Carnival #4 – Officials Accreditation

Youth/Senior Modified Carnival #5 – Officials Accreditation

Set Up & Pack Up Roster

All Clubs are required to provide 1 member per carnival they attend for set up and pack up shifts. These members are required to sign on with an LSV staff representative before commencing their shift and sign off after their shift.
