## Entries

- Entries for the carnivals are now open and will close 11:00pm Sunday, 9 January 2022
- Entries for the carnivals will be \$32.00 per competitor
- There are NO LATE ENTRIES and NO SCRATCHINGS
- All entries can be made via the LSV online entry system, [SportApp](#) – located on the [LSV website](#).
- Officials and Water Safety volunteers **must be** entered into [SportApp](#) **by 11.00pm Monday, 10 January 2022**.
- Powercraft volunteers must be entered into SportApp **by 11.00pm Sunday, 2 January**.

## Eligibility

Ensure the following before trying to enter competitors and before emailing and requesting help:

1. Members must be Active 2021/22 members to be eligible for entry.
2. All competitors have relevant awards processed in SurfGuard (if they do not have the award in SurfGuard they cannot be entered)
3. Competitors have competitive rights to your club (e.g., transfer has been approved)
4. All competitors have completed vaccination link (where relevant) - Anyone aged 18 years and older who is attending a facility or is involved with any of our services, programs, and/or activities, must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Please ensure relevant athletes and officials wanting to participate in the above carnivals, have completed their vaccination status [online form](#) **before** completing entries. If not completed, they will be ineligible to enter or attend. LSV's COVID-19 Vaccination FAQ can be found [here](#).



### U13 Competition at Senior Carnivals:

With the addition of the U13 age group at the 2022 Aussies, there will be two opportunities for U13's to enter senior carnivals to gain exposure to this setting. **This opportunity is encouraged primarily for those U13 athletes who are intending to compete at Aussies in 2022.**

Under 13 athletes are only permitted to compete in the programmed U13 events for each specific carnival. These carnivals are Anglesea on Sunday 16 January and Lorne on Sunday 13 February and have been selected as they are typically suitable for this age group's ability and also similar to what the athletes may experience at Aussies.

Note: Clubs that enter U13 athletes into these carnivals will be required to provide additional water safety personnel (board/tube).

Please note the below which has been updated in the Senior Handbook relating to U13 competition at Senior carnivals:

1. U13s are only permitted to compete in the following nominated Senior Carnivals: Anglesea (Sunday 16th January 2022) and Lorne (Sunday 13th February 2022).
2. U13 Competitors are ONLY permitted to compete in programmed U13 individual or programmed team events.
3. U13 age competitors must remain in the U13 age category for individual events and shall not be permitted to compete in any older age division in individual events, even if they turn 13 during a season and obtain, or are eligible to obtain, the SLSA Surf Rescue Certificate. With the exception of the specific U13– U15 5 person R&R event, U13 age competitors are eligible to compete in designated U13 and U14 team events only.
4. U13 competitors in individual board events will be required to compete on a nipper board.
5. U13 competitors competing in U13/U14 team events that require the use of a board will be required to use a Mal ONLY. Team Managers must ensure that U13 competitors have the required level of proficiency in using a Mal in surf conditions in these team events.
6. U13 competitors will be competing on U14/U15 Youth Carnival courses (positioning of the buoys may be adjusted longer dependant on the surf conditions at both Anglesea and Lorne).

- A new function has been added to SportApp allowing Team Managers the ability to make a submission informing the LSV IT Development Support team of any individuals that are unable to be entered. The function can be found on the Entry page. Most importantly, every Team Manager MUST ensure all competitors are entered before the close of entries AND have submitted via the provided form for any competitors that were unable to be entered. No late entries will be accepted. Team Managers are also reminded that all Transfers of Competitive Rights MUST be fully completed before close of entries.

### Officials, Water Safety & Powercraft

Clubs are to ensure that they meet their Official's/Water Safety & Powercraft requirements as per the [2021/2022 Senior Team Managers and Officials Handbook](#). Clubs **must** enter the names of their volunteers via SportApp **by 11.00pm Monday, 10 January 2022. PLEASE ensure they have the correct qualifications.**

### Shallow Water Rescue Team

A Shallow Water Rescue Team (SWRT) shall be implemented for the duration of each carnival. Their function is to provide an immediate search and rescue capability when it has been reported that a competitor or official is missing in shallow water within the competition boundaries. Each attending club must supply one volunteer to be part of the Shallow Water Rescue Team. Please add details in SportApp with your volunteer/s details who meets the following criteria **by 11.00pm Monday, 10 January 2022.**



#### Criteria:

- 18 + Years old
- Bronze Medallion Proficient
- Competent in surf conditions
- Emotionally mature to handle Search and Rescue situations

There will be a meeting of all Shallow Water Rescue Team members with the SEMC before the carnival commences.
