Youth/Senior Full Carnival #3 – Officials Accreditation

Clubs are encouraged to upskill members so that accredited (Technical/Senior) officials are nominated for all carnivals. All officials must hold a valid Working with Children Check (WWCC) and be a financial member of a club.

Technical/Senior Officials – can officiate at Junior/Youth/Senior/Masters Carnivals

The online accreditation courses for Technical Officials can be accessed through the SLSA Members Area (https://members.sls.com.au/SLSA_Online/modules/login/index.php).

Once the online components have been completed, members can then register for a practical/assessment. Practical assessments will be conducted at the Lorne Youth/Senior Carnival. [Click here](#) for further information. Places for this practical will close on Friday 31 January.

Set Up & Pack Up Roster

All Clubs are required to provide 1 member per carnival they attend for set up and pack up shifts. These members are required to sign on with an LSV staff representative before commencing their shift and sign off after their shift. Set up shifts will commence at 6:30am and pack up shifts to commence as requested over the PA system.

Photography

- Before any photographs are taken by any person(s), photographers must obtain a media identification wristband that must be worn for the duration of the event.
- Media wristbands can be obtained by registering at the Life Saving Victoria Carnival Administration tent.
- Proof of Working with Children Check must be provided at registration.
