CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS	NOTES
<p><b>1. Gather required equipment required for cleaning</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Waste bags – general and bio-hazardous waste 'yellow' bags</li> <li>Cleaning/disinfectant wipes or spray Disposable/single use cloths</li> <li>Mop, bucket and disinfectant cleaning solution (Dilute disinfectant cleaning solution in mop bucket as per manufacturer instructions)</li> </ul>	
<p><b>2. Apply clean personal protective equipment, and adopt Medical Precautions</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Perform hand hygiene</li> <li>Gloves</li> <li>P2/N95 mask</li> <li>Protective eyewear</li> </ul>	<p><b>Hand Hygiene:</b></p> <p>Hand hygiene is the practice of reducing the number of micro-organisms on the hands. It refers to two common forms of hand cleansing:</p> <p><b>Hand rub</b> - application of a waterless antimicrobial agent (for example, alcohol-based hand rub) to the surface of the hands.</p> <p><b>Hand wash</b> - use of water and soap or soap solution (whether plain or antimicrobial), followed by patting dry with single-use towels.</p>
<p><b>3. Clean all equipment and the clinical area with cleaning/disinfectant wipes or spray and single use/disposable cloths</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Clean all equipment and surfaces which have been in contact with the patient</li> <li>Clean all surfaces frequently touched during transport and care of the patient</li> <li>Clean all flat surfaces paying particular attention to high touch areas and work surfaces, the exterior of equipment used, patient assessment equipment, first aid bed, rails, door handles and any other surface used or touched</li> <li>Allow surfaces to dry</li> </ul> <p>Note: doors should remain open during cleaning to allow adequate ventilation while cleaning is completed.</p>	<p>Avoid cleaning methods which may disperse microbes into the air by using sweeping products or spray and wipe techniques.</p> <p>Reusable patient treatment equipment including oxygen, spinal board, blood pressure cuff and cable and equipment bags must be cleaned using disinfectant wipes.</p> <p>Any vehicle (4x4, ATV) control panels, steering wheel, and radios should be wiped with disinfectant wipes/solution.</p>

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS	NOTES
<p><b>4. Remove waste from incident location/club facility</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• General waste should be placed in a bag before being disposed of in a normal waste bin</li><li>• Hazardous waste should be placed in a tied bio-hazardous waste 'yellow' bag, or suitable container before being disposed of in a bio-hazardous waste bin</li></ul> <p>Note: doors should remain open during cleaning to allow adequate ventilation while cleaning is completed.</p>
