Pre-requisites

This course requires a reasonable level of physical fitness.

It is recommended that candidates are 12 years in the calendar year they undertake the course.

Online Learning

Online learning is required for candidates on blended courses and must be completed prior to attending the face-to-face component of the course. Useful hints and tips include:

- Although tablet devices can be used, the online learning is best viewed on a laptop or PC
- Use Google Chrome as your browser for best performance
- Disable your pop-up blockers to allow the online learning content to launch quickly and easily
